



Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro Public Safety Advisory for controlled release of water

October 29, 2013 – Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro is advising residents, cabin owners and travellers that reservoir levels are above normal for this time of year.

There is potential for the controlled release of water at Star Lake in Central Newfoundland. Release of water may soon begin at Star Lake Spillway into Star Brook and then Red Indian Lake.

People are advised to use this area with great caution as water levels and flows are higher than normal and may be unpredictable. Water releases at spillways could begin at any time.
